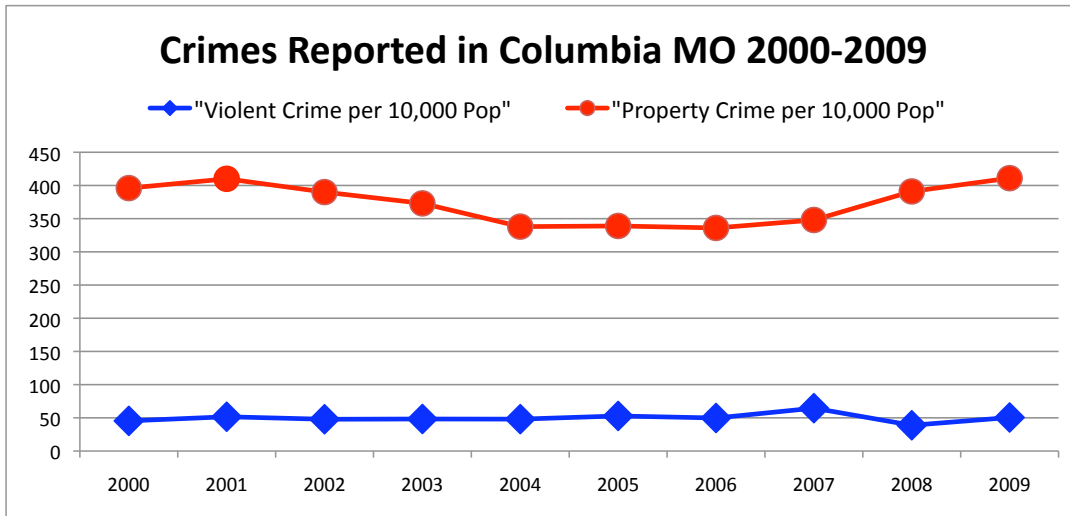


**Summary of Crime Data for Columbia, MO, 2000-2009**  
**from FBI and MO State Highway Patrol Uniform Crime Reports**

Violent crime peaked in 2007. The rate of violent crimes (murder, forcible rape, robbery & aggravated assault) in 2009 was comparable to that in 2006 & 2001.

The rate of property crimes (burglary, larceny, theft, motor vehicle theft & arson) in 2009 was higher than in recent years but comparable to that in 2001.
